The purpose of developing this database was to identify educational courses with a focus on agricultural safety and health, in post-secondary associate degree, technical degree, and certificate programs in colleges within UMASH Center's five-state region of Minnesota (MN), Wisconsin (WI), Iowa (IA), North Dakota (ND), and South Dakota (SD). First, an internet search was performed to identify degree programs in MN, WI, IA, ND, and SD within the following general categories: agriculture, agribusiness and farm business, animal sciences, diesel/heavy equipment technology. The degree programs were then filtered to exclude four-year and graduate degree programs. Curricula and course descriptions were found on the websites of colleges with relevant degree programs. Courses with application to agricultural health and safety were identified.

Numbers of schools in which courses with agricultural safety and were identified are as follows: MN – 7; WI – 13; IA – 16; ND – 7; SD – 4. Number of classes identified was 152. Of note, 19 courses were found to specifically focus of agricultural health and safety (or first aid/CPR classes required in the ag curriculum):

It should be noted that programs in horticulture, ornamental plants, plant science, industry, and firefighting for example, were not specifically sought out. However, if courses including an agricultural health/safety component in these fields were found incidentally, they were included in the list of courses. This represents an overestimate for relevant courses when considering our initial search criteria. Additional relevant courses would likely be found if the search criteria were extended.
