

# Women in Agriculture

## Upper Midwest Region

According to 2012 Census of Agriculture 14% of the nation's 2.1 million farms had a female primary operator, down 2% since 2007.

### Fast Facts

#### ● Upper Midwest Totals ●

- Average age of women primary operators is 61 years, the same as the national average
- 35% of women primary operators list "farming" as their primary occupation
- Farms with women as primary operators were responsible for 1.72% of crop sales and 1.92% of livestock sales

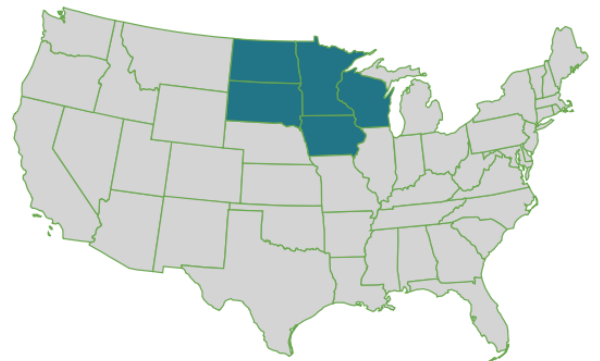
