Each farm operation is unique in the number and types of farm buildings and shops. These structures are crucial to farm operation, but may also pose potential safety risks. The checklist below lists a few common hazards you can look for and fix to keep your employees and family safe.

Are all buildings free of trash, junk or tools in the walkways and work areas?			
Are wood floors free of rotten or broken floorboards, exposed nails or other defects?

Are low ceilings, doors or beams marked with warning signs, streamers, or other identification?
