

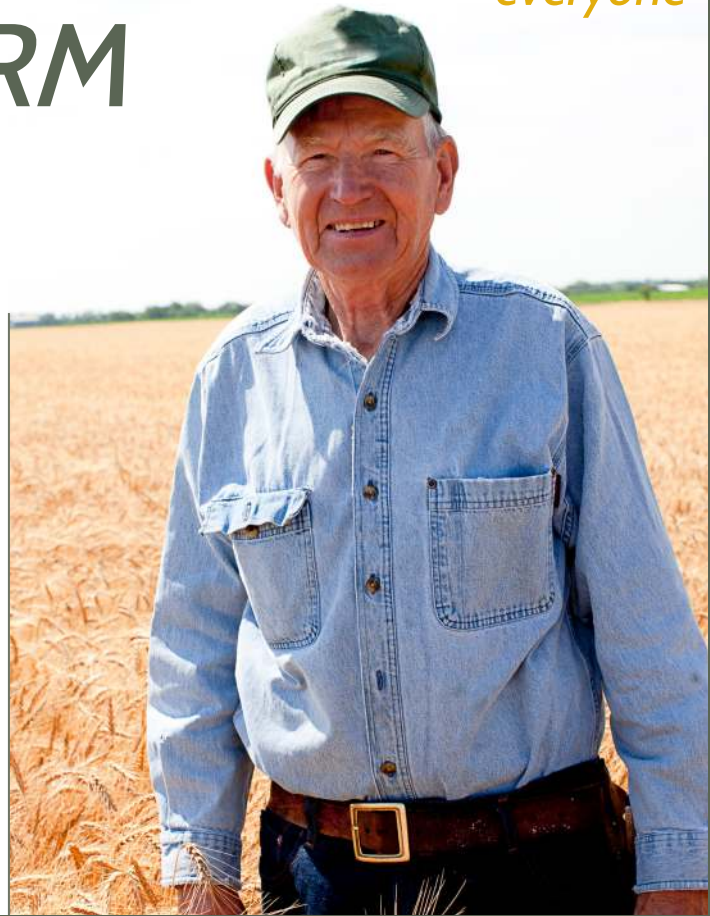
# AGING ON THE FARM
