## WHEN MOVING COWS, BE PALS!




Be Patient Consider the Angle of your approach Think about your Location relative to the cow Slow the Speed of your movements

## HAVE PATIENCE! THE COW IS ALWAYS RIGHT.

Cows move consistently and predictably.

If a cow is not moving the way you'd like her to, reassess the signals you are giving her.



- Start cow movement by slowly approaching the cow's pressure zone
- Give a cow time and space to react to you
- Walk at a speed that keeps you out of the cow's **flight zone**
- The angle at which you approach a cow will influence the direction she moves.
