Has everyone on the farm, including families, been educated on how people get and spread COVID-19?			
Have you identified <u>ways</u> that your team is at risk of getting or spreading COVID-19?			
Have you created a <u>plan</u> for how you and your team will reduce the risk of getting COVID-19 and stop it from spreading to other employees, family members, and community members?			
Do you have a plan if someone is unable to work?			
Do you meet with your team regularly to go over this plan and change it if need be? Are you meeting via phone call or video chat? If that's not an option, are you meeting outside with everyone standing more than 6 feet apart and wearing N95 respirators or cloth face masks?			
Is someone providing this training for employees whose first language is not English?			
Have you put up posters with your plan in break rooms, at entrances, in housing, and in other commonly-used spaces? The posters should include images and text in languages spoken by each employee.			
Are employees' names/addresses/contact/emergency information available for owners and managers to easily access?			
Do you have whistleblower protection policies so that anyone can report unsafe practices and make suggestions without fear of retaliation?
