
2022 Farm Safety Beliefs 🦼

At the 2022 National FFA Convention, UMASH surveyed 910 students & 66 adults

from across the United States about their beliefs about farm safety.

Many believed they would be less likely to be injured on the farm if they...



students believed no matter what they do, farm injuries will still happen. Students with previous safety training were more likely to strongly agree that there were actions they could take to

make injuries less likely.

more likely than adults to believe that enough practice could make injuries less likely.

While most agreed that there were actions they could take to prevent injuries, 80% still thought that injuries on the farm would happen no matter what.

Injuries on the farm are preventable.
